Revised California WaterFix Proposal**

*Important Step Forward in Plan to Secure Delta Water Supply, Modernize Infrastructure*

**Los Angeles, CA** – *The California Department of Water Resources and Bureau of Reclamation today released a joint [Partially Recirculated Draft Environmental Impact Report/Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement](#) for the governor’s California WaterFix plan to modernize water infrastructure in the Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta.*
